Starting as a CNA, Robin progressed to Chief Operating Officer of a small multi-state organization where she oversaw operations and risk management, worked through Medicare changes related to the Balanced Budget Act, implemented Prospective Payment System, managed reorganizations, and managed the response to two full scale and one partial disaster involving three 120-bed SNFs. After Hurricane Charlie devastated South West Florida, Ms. Bleier contracted with the Department of Health. She established and managed a community special medical need facility program. She was the primary contributor to the Florida Health Care Association (FHCA) Disaster Management Guide. Ms. Bleier is a published author, renowned presenter and elder-related Clinical Risk and Operations Consultant.
